

Byram Township Police Department Annual Major Discipline Reports

Pursuant to Internal Affairs Policy and Procedures Section 9.11.2, every state, county, and local law enforcement agency in New Jersey is required to submit to the Attorney General and the County Prosecutor, and publish on the agency's public website, a brief synopsis of all complaints where the following occurred: termination; reduction in rank or grade; suspension of more than 5 days; sustained finding that an officer: used discrimination or bias; used excessive force; was untruthful or lacked candor; filed a false report or submitted a false certification; intentionally conducted a false search, seizure or arrest; intentionally mishandled or destroyed evidence; domestic violence and/or, an instance where an officer resigned, retired, transferred or separated from an agency while any internal affairs investigation or complaint was pending and/or if an officer was charged with an indictable crime.
